Big Ideas

- Focus on the big picture.
- Give your students a chance to work ahead and/or catch up if they're behind.
- Put all of your info together in one place and give them access to it early.
- Grace: give and accept it. This isn't easy for anyone involved.
- Give the students autonomy as much as possible. Student choice is powerful.

- Make use of available resources, but use caution when asking students to access new resources.

Multimedia

Use graphics when possible to communicate your ideas better.

Pre-Training

Ensure that learners know names and characteristics of key concepts.

Segment

Manage the complexity by breaking a lesson into parts.

Coherence

Minimize interesting but irrelevant information.
